SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR TENANT

IMPROVEMENT TO CAMP COMMERCE CABIN # 11

MEETING DATE: JANUARY 8, 2019

RECOMMENDATION:

Allocate \$76,000.00, as approved by the Measure AA Committee, costs associated with the tenant improvement of Camp Commerce Cabin #11.

ANALYSIS/BACKGROUND:

In November 2018, Camp Commerce Cabin # 11 became vacant. With inspection of this cabin, it was noted that several deficiencies in this cabin required immediate attention. These deficiencies range from flooring damage, structural modifications, plumbing, electrical and heating. Staff continues to performing several tasks associated with required improvements in an effort to minimize cost for this project. However, several of these tasks will require outsourcing to a contractor. These consist of the following:
