SUBJECT: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BLODGETT BAYLOSIS ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING, PURSUANT TO AN EXISTING ON-CALL SERVICES AGREEMENT, TO CONDUCT THE APPROPRIATE ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) FOR A PROPOSED PROJECT AT 6210 GARFIELD AVENUE

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution authorizing Blodgett Baylosis Environmental Planning, to conduct the appropriate environmental analysis pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for a proposed project at 6210 Garfield Avenue, in the amount of \$31,983 (which includes a ten percent contingency) pursuant to their existing on-call services agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Blodgett Baylosis Environmental Planning is a full service environmental consulting firm serving a variety of public and private sector clients throughout Southern California. The firm has many years of experience preparing environmental documents such as, Initial Studies, Negative Declarations, Mitigated Negative Declarations and Environmental Impact Reports for compliance with CEQA.

Public Works and Development Services staff is currently reviewing an application for the development of a proposed two stories 197,000 square foot self storage facility at 6210 Garfield Avenue on a 5.39 acre lot. The proposed development is subject to review pursuant to CEQA. CEQAQ requires potential environmental impacts related to proposed projects to be analyzed. Staff recommends that the City Council authorize Blodgett Baylosis Environmental Planning, to perform said work. The cost for completing the subject work will be \$29,076, plus a ten percent contingency, for a total of \$31,983.
