## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-\_\_\_**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE MEASURE AA FUND REQUEST AND CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER FOR THE CITYWIDE TRAFFIC SIGN REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION OF NO OVERNIGHT PARKING SIGNS THROUGHOUT THE CITY

**WHEREAS**, on August 21, 2018, the City Council awarded a contract to Myers and Sons Hi-Way Safety, Inc. (Hi-Way Safety) in the amount of \$64,775 in order to replace the aging and worn-down regulatory and warning traffic signs throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the project was completed in December 2018, and concurrently, City was seeking the services of a contractor to manufacture and install nearly 600 signs throughout the City. These signs were for NO OVERNIGHT PARKING signs and would provide City Community Service Officers and the law enforcement to issue tickets to the violators; and

**WHEREAS**, Hi-Way Safety provided Staff a proposal and estimate in the amount of \$103,125 that includes all labor and material costs, including sign fabrication, parts, delivery, and installation of approximately over six-hundred (600) NO OVERNIGHT PARKING signs; and

**WHEREAS**, remaining funds in the Citywide Traffic Sign Replacement Project is approximately \$26,136 and will be augmented by an additional \$81,742 that was recommended by the Measure AA Committee on August 14, 2018, contingent upon the approval by the City Council, which will bring the total amount to \$107,878.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Approve the Measure AA fund request of \$81,742 into the Citywide Traffic Sign Replacement Project (Account No. 41-5170-520001.14648) that was recommended by the Measure AA Committee during its regularly scheduled meeting on August 14, 2018.

<u>Section 2.</u> Approve the Contract Change Order No. 1 for Myers and Sons Hi-Way Safety, Inc. in the amount of \$107,878 for the installation of the NO OVERNIGHT PARKING signs throughout the City.
