RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH CALIFORNIA FACILITY SPECIALIST

WHEREAS, Council will approve a bid by California Facility Specialist and direct staff to finalize all required documentation and proceed with the purchase and installation of 6 basketball backboard systems for the Veterans Memorial Park Gymnasium and direct Contractor of record PMKPro Electrical to provide electrical service to manufacture connection end point; and

WHEREAS, an allocation of \$65,000 was presented and approved by the Measure AA Committee at its meeting of January 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of January 8, 2019, Council allocated \$65,000 as recommended for approval by Measure AA Committee, for costs associated with the purchase and installation of 6 basketball backboard systems for the Veterans Memorial Park Gymnasium; and

WHEREAS, Electrical service will be provided by PMKPro Electrical (contractor of record) for power at the manufacture connection end points for a cost not to exceed \$5,000; and

WHEREAS, Staff is requesting \$50,350 of the approved allocation for the structural reinforcement, purchase and installation of 6 basketball backboard systems, including contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council for the City of Commerce finds and declares that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and incorporates said recitals fully into this Resolution as substantive findings.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Council approves the allocation of \$50,350 for the structural reinforcement, purchase and installation of 6 basketball backboard systems, including contingency.

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Council for the City of Commerce hereby approves staff to proceed with an agreement between the City of Commerce and California Facility Specialist.

<u>Section 4</u>. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.
