Model City Cancer Fighters (MCCF)

- I. Mission Statement – Model City Cancer Fighters are committed to promoting cancer awareness in the City of Commerce by hosting community events to raise money for cancer research, hosting annual walks and participating in volunteer activities to support the loved ones of a cancer patient.**

II. Elections and Officers

- a. Club elections will be held during the 1st Month of January – Nominations will be proposed and submitted during this same meeting from any member from the floor.**
- b. Officers must be residents of the City of Commerce.**
- c. Cabinet will consist of the President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary**
- d. Should a vacancy occur President, can appoint a member to vacant cabinet position until the next club election. (Will finish out term).**

III. Fees and Dues

- a. At this time, no annual due will be established – Unanimous consent will be needed from club members to establish a member due.**
- b. A majority of the club may approve any expenses incurred and/or for donations to be made on behalf of the club over \$100.**
- c. The President, and or his designee, may spend up to \$100 without being subject to a vote but must provide a detailed breakdown to the Treasurer.**
- d. Any Office or Member may be reimbursed for prior approved expenses.**

III. Special Meetings

- a. A special meeting can be convened if a majority of the cabinet approves and with a 72-hour notice.**
- b. If a special meeting needs to be call before the 72 hours unanimous consent is needed from cabinet or a majority from club members.**

V. Meeting Protocol

- a. President will chair club meetings – If President unavailable, then the chair shall proceed in the following succession: Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary.**
- b. Guests are allotted 5 minutes to speak.**
- c. Club shall not endorse any candidate for public office nor will politics nor sectarian religion be debated by members.**

VI. Amendments

- a. The above standing rules made by amended by a 2/3 Vote of members present during regular club meeting.**
- b. Amendments may be voted on at the same meeting they are introduced.**
