**MEETING DATE:** March 5, 2019

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve Contract Change Order No. 2 for the fabrication and installation of signs around Bandini Elementary School and throughout the City.

## **BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:**

On January 8, 2019, the City Council approved the Revised Bandini Elementary School Parking & Traffic Control Implementation Plan as a mitigation effort to reduce traffic congestion during school children pick-ups and drop-offs. Staff is requesting that the City Council approve Contract Change Order No. 2 to Hi-Way Safety in the amount of \$15,745, in order to fabricate and install signs around Bandini Elementary School and throughout the City.

Hi-Way Safety provided Staff a proposal and estimate in the amount of \$15,745 (see *Attachment 1*) that includes all labor and material costs, including sign fabrication, parts, delivery, and installation for the parking enforcement signs around Bandini Elementary School. This action was approved by the City Council on January 8, 2019 to reduce traffic congestion and improve safety during pick-ups and drop-offs of school children.

Therefore, Staff is requesting that the City Council approve Contract Change Order No. 2 to Hi-Way Safety in the amount of \$15,745, in order to fabricate and install signs and curb markings around Bandini Elementary School and throughout the City (see *Attachment 2*).

#### FISCAL IMPACT

Staff has requested and for the City Council to approve a funding request of \$15,745 that was recommended on March 5, 2019, during the regularly scheduled meeting of the Measure AA Advisory Committee. This added funding will be used to defray the costs of

fabricating and installing signs around Bandini Elementary School and throughout the City.
