A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, TO APPROVE \$35,000 OF MEASURE AA FUNDS TO FABRICATE AND INSTALL "NO VEHICLE DWELLING SIGNS" THROUGHOUT THE CITY AND INSTALL SIGNS AND CURB MARKINGS AROUND BANDINI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, it has been determined that additional signage related to "NO VEHICLE DWELLING" is necessary in order to clarify that the parking of vehicles along city streets for the purpose of human habitation or dwelling is now unauthorized, as now promulgated in the newly revised Traffic and Parking Section of the Commerce Municipal Code (CMC); and

WHEREAS, the additional amount for these extra signs is \$14,250; and

WHEREAS, staff is requesting that an additional \$15,745 be allocated in order to fabricate and install signs around Bandini Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, during its regularly scheduled meeting on March 5, 2019, the Measure AA Advisory Committee recommended the allocation of \$35,000 of these Measure AA funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Approve \$35,000 to be added to project account no. 43-5170-52001.14648 in order to defray the costs of fabricating and installing the additionally requested signs and curb markings for "NO VEHICLE DWELLING" and Bandini Elementary School.
