A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT AND ADDITION TO THE CALIFORNIA HIGH SPEED RAIL AUTHORITY AGREEMENTS

- **WHEREAS**, the High Speed Rail (HSR) was one of the key components of the adopted American Recovery Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009; and
- **WHEREAS**, in 2008, the California High Speed Rail, also known as the High Speed Train System, was approved by voters under Proposition 1A allocating almost \$10 billion to HSR; and
- **WHEREAS**, the California High Speed Rail Authority (CHSRA) is tasked with all planning, design, environmental impact and operational phases of the statewide rail network and Los Angeles would serve as a major terminus.; and
- **WHEREAS**, the proposed segment from Los Angeles to Anaheim will be constructed along the BNSF corridor which passes through the City of Commerce.
- WHEREAS, CHSRA entered into a reimbursement agreement with the City of Commerce where the costs to perform technical engineering review of the proposed alignment will be reimbursed by the CHSRA; and
- **WHEREAS**, the reimbursement also covers staff and consultant costs associated with identifying potential conflicts with the City's infrastructure, as well as any other costs, and to coordinate communications with the CHSRA; and
- **WHEREAS**, on June 21, 2016, Council approved the City's agreement with the California High Speed Rail Authority with a budget amount of \$400,000 and a contract term from January 1, 2016 through June 1, 2019; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City brought on-board, as its subconsultants, Southstar Engineering & Consulting, Inc. (Southstar) to conduct environmental and engineering services, and JM Diaz, Inc. to perform civil engineering design services; and
- **WHEREAS**, Southstar has completed significant analysis of all plans and technical memos provided by the CHSRA team, has developed technical concepts and recommendations at several high priority/focus areas, and has written the City's technical memorandum to CHSRA recommending the concepts that the City Council approved; and
- **WHEREAS**, the civil engineering and design component of the agreement had not been started and staff recommends Mott MacDonald, LLC to perform this task with an estimated budget of \$80,000.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Amendment 1 to extend the City's agreement with the California High Speed Rail Authority to January 21, 2021 is hereby approved;
- <u>Section 2</u>. Amendment 1 to extend Southstar Engineering and Consulting, Inc.'s agreement with the City to January 21, 2021 is hereby approved.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Retain Mott MacDonald, LLC to provide civil engineering and design services, pursuant to their on-call agreement, with a contract term of June 4, 2019 to January 21, 2021 is hereby approved.
- <u>Section 4</u>. The Mayor, or the City's representative, is authorized to execute the Agreements for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.
