A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH CALIFORNIA FACILITY SPECIALIST; AND APPROVING AN ALLOCATION FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN INDOOR GYM DIVIDER AND RELATED COSTS

WHEREAS, the Veterans Park Gymnasium is presently one large open area; and

WHEREAS, a gymnasium divider curtain will allow for the most effective use out of the Veterans Park Gymnasium by dividing a large open space into smaller sections for various sports and other events; and

WHEREAS, divider curtains provide safety, visual privacy and a sound barrier between spaces; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce received only two bids for the undertaking of this project as it is a specialized kind of trade, with California Facility Specialist being the lowest bidder;

WHEREAS, City staff is seeking approval of California Facility Specialist's bid, and authority to finalize all required documentation and proceed with the purchase and installation of an indoor gym divider curtain at the Veterans Park Gymnasium and the electrical services associated with the project;

WHEREAS, City staff is also requesting \$23,178.00 of the approved allocation for the purchase and installation an indoor gym divider, including contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council for the City of Commerce finds and declares that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and incorporates said recitals fully into this Resolution as substantive findings.

Section 2. The City Council approves the allocation of \$23,178.00 for the purchase and installation of the indoor gym divider curtain, including contingency.

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Council for the City of Commerce hereby approves staff to proceed with an agreement between the City of Commerce and California Facility Specialist.

Section 4. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.
