A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF PROPOSED RED CURB MARKINGS AT BOTH ENDS OF THE EXISTING DRIVEWAY LOCATED ALONG 7222 EAST GAGE AVENUE IN ORDER TO IMPROVE SIGHT DISTANCE AND TRAFFIC SAFETY

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 21458 and Commerce Municipal Code (CMC) Section 10.44.030 authorize the City of Commerce (City) to place and maintain regulatory curb markings within the City and also that the City Council by way of ordinance or resolution, through the authority of the City Administrator / Manager, City Engineer, or the Public Works & Development Services Director, may install or paint regulatory curb markings; and

WHEREAS, Staff completed traffic analyses consistent with the California Manual on Traffic Control Devices (CA MUTCD) and the CVC for the proposed red curb markings along 7222 East Gage Avenue; and

WHEREAS, during its regularly scheduled meeting on June 12, 2019, the Traffic Commission recommended that the red curb markings be installed along 7222 East Gage Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the proposed red curb markings is based on engineering judgment and analysis.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Per CVC Section 21458 and per CMC Section 10.44.030, the City is authorized to place and maintain regulatory curb markings within the City, and also that the City Council by way of ordinance or resolution, through the authority of the City Administrator / Manager, City Engineer, or the Public Works & Development Services Director, may install or paint regulatory curb markings.

<u>Section 2.</u> Red curb markings denoting NO PARKING at all times shall be installed along 7222 East Gage Avenue, consistent with the appropriate code sections of the CVC, CMC, and the CA MUTCD.
