RESOLUTION NO. 19-____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA APPROVING TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURES FOR THE 2019 TRICK OR TROT 5K RUN

WHEREAS, every year, the City of Commerce normally hosts the Turkey Trot during November around Thanksgiving that is held in the morning in which the routes are within the Rosewood Park neighborhood area; and

WHEREAS, as was done last year in 2018, the Turkey Trot will be rescheduled and re-named as the Trick or Trot and will be held on Saturday, October 26, 2019; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure a safe and worthwhile event, Public Works staff procured a traffic control plan that exhibits all the traffic control devices required to provide adequate traffic safety for this event; and

WHEREAS, the traffic control plan requires the closure of certain streets in order for the Turkey Trot to be effective. California Vehicle Code Section 21101(e), provides that local authorities may by ordinance or resolution, temporarily close a portion of any street under their jurisdiction for "celebrations, parades, local special events, and other purposes" when necessary for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing; and

WHEREAS, the annual cost of approximately \$800 for the rental of the required traffic control devices will be absorbed by the 2019/2020 fiscal year budget, which has adequate funds to defray the aforementioned costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The following temporary street closures for the Trick or Trot that is to be held on Saturday, October 26, 2019 between the hours of 5:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. are hereby approved:

- Eastern Avenue (one lane northbound from Harbor Street to Jillson Street)
- Commerce Way (between Harbor Street and Jillson Street)
- Jillson Street (between Eastern Avenue and Boris Avenue)
- Harbor Street (between Commerce Way and Eastern Avenue)
- Rosewood Area (Bartmus Street, Jardine Street, Leo Avenue, and Boris Avenue)
- The Village (Entrada Street, Mission Way, Fairgrounds Street, Village Drive, and Plaza Street)
