SUBJECT: Weed Abatement –Public Hearing

MEETING DATE: February 18, 2020

RECOMMENDATION:

- 1) Conduct public hearing.
- 2) Approve the Abatement Order directing the Los Angeles County Agricultural Commissioner/Director of Weights and Measures to abate the seasonal and recurrent public nuisance declared under Resolution by having the weeds, brush, rubbish, and refuse removed from specified properties.

ANALYSIS:

The City Council declared, by approving Resolution on February 4, 2020, that weeds, brush, rubbish and refuse upon or in front of specified properties in the City are a seasonal and recurrent public nuisance and further declared its intention to provide for the abatement of said nuisance.

This public hearing is held annually to allow those property owners affected by the Los Angeles County Agricultural Commissioner/Director of Weights and Measures' weed abatement program to protest the inclusion of their properties within the program.

The Agricultural Commissioner/Director of Weights and Measures has notified by mail each of the property owners affected by the program.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This activity can be carried out without additional impact on the current operating budget.
