**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE,
CALIFORNIA, APPROVING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND AUTHORIZATION TO
ADVERTISE THE CONSTRUCTION BID PACKAGE FOR THE TRAFFIC
INTERCONNECT SYSTEM UPGRADES PROJECT**

WHEREAS, in April 2015, Caltrans announced the Cycle 7 Call for Projects for the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the HSIP program is to achieve a significant reduction in traffic fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads, including non-State-owned public roads and tribal lands; and

WHEREAS, City submitted a grant application which focused on improving traffic signal interconnectivity along Eastern Avenue, Telegraph Road, Slauson Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, and Garfield Avenue and received approval for \$935,280 in grant funds as part of the program with a required 10% local match of \$103,920, and

WHEREAS, Staff has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that it is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to its CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the City Council approve the construction project plans, specifications, and estimates (PS&E) for this Project and authorize Staff to advertise the Notice Inviting Bids.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Project Plans, Specifications, and Estimates (PS&E) for the Traffic Interconnect System Upgrades Project are hereby approved.

Section 2. Staff is authorized to proceed with advertisement of the Notice Inviting Bids.
