SUBJECT: Resolution Reciting the Facts and Ratifying the Results of the Special Municipal Election Held on June 2, 2020

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve a Resolution ratifying the results of the Special Municipal Election held on June 2, 2020.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The City Council adopted Resolution 2020-020 - Calling for a Special Municipal Election scheduled for Tuesday, June 2, 2020. The purpose of the election was to submit two (2) referendum measures to consider Ordinance No. 731 and Ordinance No. 732, Measure C and Measure CC, respectively. The City Council also approved Resolution 2019-09 - Requesting specified Services from the County of Los Angeles as it relates to the Special election. The County completed and certified results on June 15, 2020. The City Clerk's office has completed the required canvas following the June 2, 2020, Special Municipal Election. Attached is the County's Certificate of the Election Results, and a Resolution reciting the results of the election for ratification by the Commerce City Council.

Elections Code Section 9217 states, "If a majority of the voters voting on a proposed ordinance vote in its favor, the ordinance shall become a valid and binding ordinance of the city. The ordinance shall be considered as adopted upon the date that the vote is declared by the legislative body, and shall go into effect 10 days after that date." City Council's approval of the attached Resoluton certifying and ratifying the results of the election will, by operation of law, make Ordinance No. 731 and Ordinance No. 732 valid and binding, and will go into effect ten (10) days after today's date.

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost for the June 2, 2020, General Election would be determined by the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder office and was included in the City's Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Mid-Year Budget.
