Subject: Notice of Department Staff's Intent to Recommend Completion of Compliance Order CO 017-003 for the City of Commerce

Dear Mayor Altamirano:

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (Department) issued the City of Commerce (City) Compliance Order CO 017-003 (Compliance Order) regarding the City's implementation of its Mandatory Commercial Recycling (MCR) law. The City has reported implementation of the conditions of the Compliance Order to the Department. In addition, the oversight period outlined in the Schedule for Compliance section 3.1 has concluded. Throughout the Compliance Order period, the Department's Jurisdiction Compliance Unit (JCU) staff verified and monitored the City's efforts to implement the programs identified in the Local Implementation Plan (LIP).

As is outlined in section 3.2 of the Compliance Order

3.2 Penalties: At the end of the oversight period, Department staff will meet with the City to assess the City's implementation efforts relating to its LIP; then Department shall hold a public hearing to determine whether or not the City has complied with all sections of this Compliance Order...

Consistent with section 3.2 of the Compliance Order, JCU staff met with the City and assessed the City's implementation efforts relating to its LIP. By way of this letter, the Department requests that the City waive the public hearing outlined in section 3.2 of the Compliance Order. Instead, the Department will present a summary of the City's actions regarding the Compliance Order and make a recommendation that the Department determine that the Compliance Order has been implemented. This presentation and recommendation would be made during the Department's regularly scheduled public monthly meeting in July.
