A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING TO AWARD CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO ELECNOR BELCO ELECTRIC, INC. FOR THE TRAFFIC INTERCONNECT SYSTEM UPGRADES PROJECT-HSIPL-5362(023) (CITY OF COMMERCE CIP NO. 2015-41); AND APPROVING A BUDGET APPROPRIATION TO ACCOUNT NUMBER 41-5170-52001.14650 RELATED TO SAME

WHEREAS, in April 2015, Caltrans announced the Cycle 7 Call for Projects for the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the HSIP program is to achieve a significant reduction in traffic fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads, including non-State-owned public roads and tribal lands; and

WHEREAS, City submitted a grant application which focused on improving traffic signal interconnectivity along Eastern Avenue, Telegraph Road, Slauson Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, and Garfield Avenue and received approval for \$935,280 in grant funds as part of the program with a required 10% local match of \$103,920; and

WHEREAS, Staff has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that it is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to its CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2020, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for the Traffic Interconnect System Upgrades Project and authorized staff to advertise the project for bid; and

WHEREAS, the construction portion of the project was advertised on March 25, 2020, with five (5) bids submitted to the City at the Bid Opening; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder for the construction contract is Elecnor Belco Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$1,257,818.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Authorize award of construction contract for the Traffic Interconnect System Upgrades Project, as delineated in Section 2 herein below.

<u>Section 2.</u> Approve a construction contract between the City of Commerce and Elecnor Belco Electric, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, for the Traffic Interconnect System

Upgrades Project, in the amount of \$1,257,818, in substantially the same form as attached, subject to final, technical revisions as required and as approved by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3.</u> Authorize Transtech Engineers, Inc. to proceed with Construction Management and Inspection Services, in the amount of \$125,781 (10% of construction cost), pursuant to their existing on-call agreement for consultant services.

<u>Section 4.</u> Authorize construction contingency in the amount of \$138,359.90 (10%) for unforeseen conditions for the aforementioned costs.

<u>Section 5.</u> Approve a budget appropriation of \$482,758.90 to account number 41-5170-52001.14650.
