SUBJECT:	CARES Act Provisions for the City's FSA Plan	

MEETING DATE: October 6, 2020

#### SUMMARY:

The City Council will consider approving optional changes to the City's FSA (Flexible Spending Account) plans as provided by the CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security) Act.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the following optional changes to the City's FSA plans. These changes are:

- Provides additional time for participants to submit claims;
- Allows prospective election changes to Healthcare and Dependent Care FSAs;
- Increase the carryover limit from \$500 to \$550.

# BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

Congress passed the CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security) Act, which has provided for FSA plan administrators to make changes to their plans. The changes are intended to provide plan participants who have been impacted by the novel coronavirus with additional tools and resources to help navigate these challenging times. If these changes are approved by City Council, staff will move forward to make these changes administratively. The City's third party administrator, The Advantage Group, will handle the administration of these changes.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact to the City. These provisions are intended to provide plan participants with additional tools and resources as we all navigate this unprecedented pandemic.
