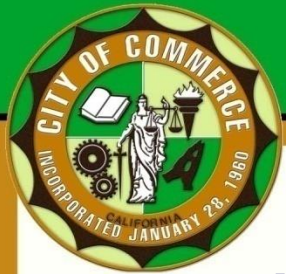

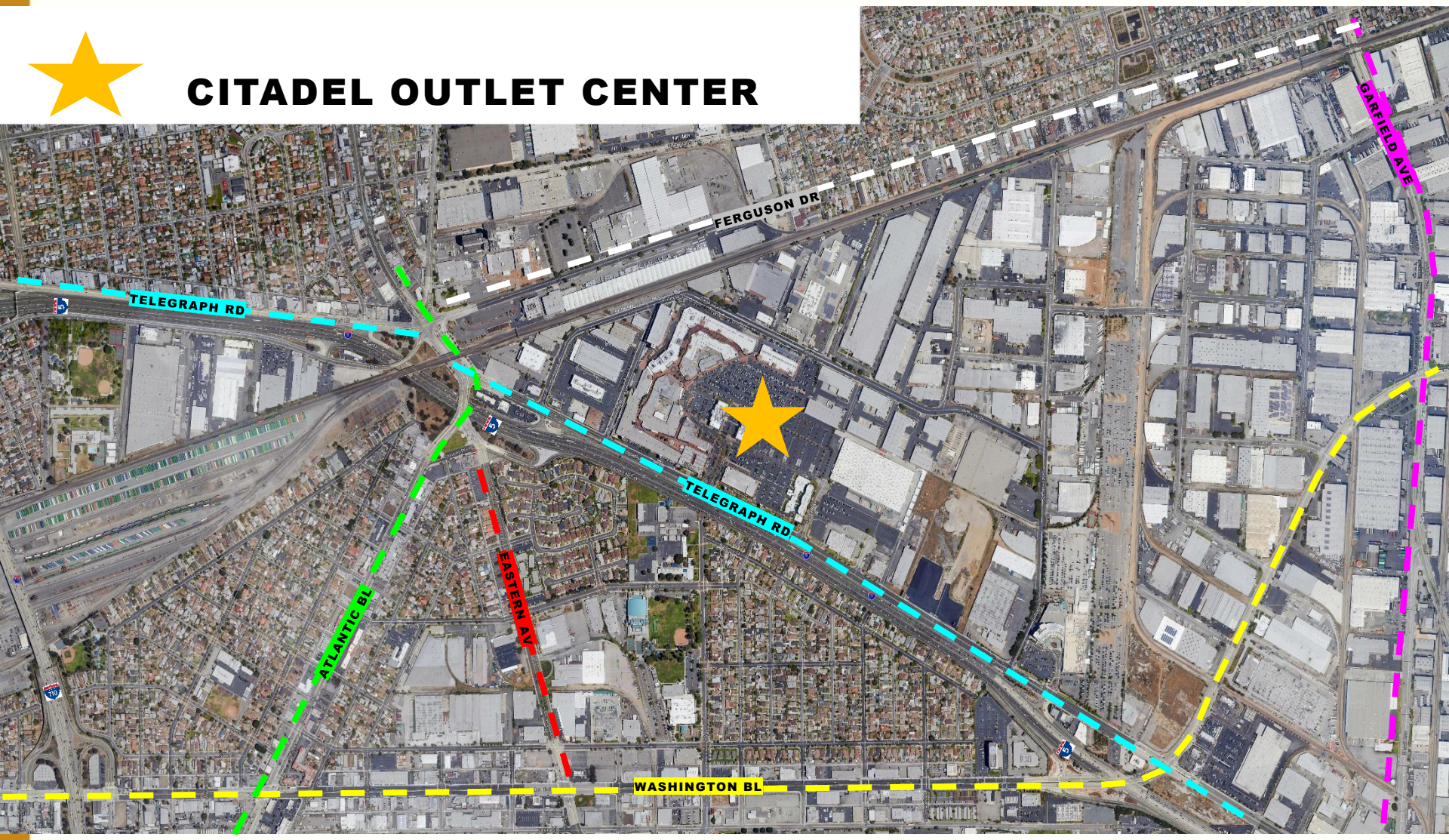


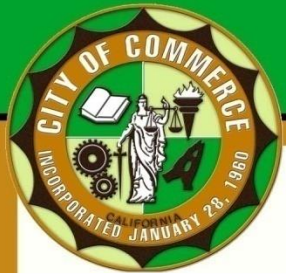

VICINITY MAP SURROUNDING AREAS CITADEL OUTLETS



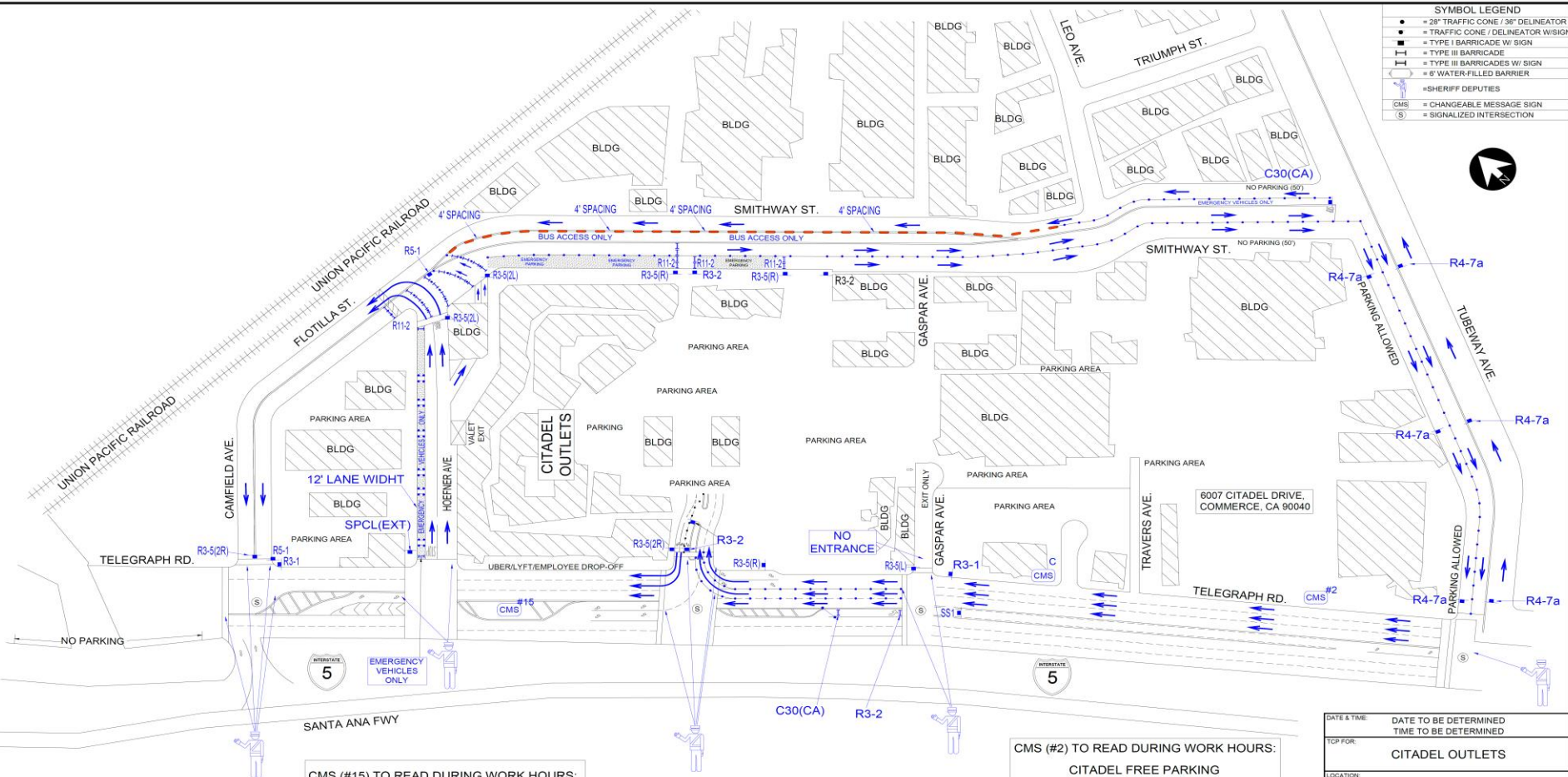

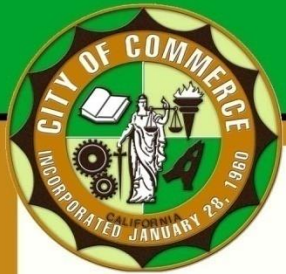

- WORK ZONE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN GENERAL NOTES**
1. ALL SIGNING, STRIPING, AND TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST EDITIONS OF THE CALIFORNIA MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (CAMUTCD), CALTRANS STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, AND/OR AS DIRECTED BY THE PERMIT ENGINEER.
 2. THERE WILL BE NO INTERFERENCE WITH TRAFFIC SIGNALS OR CROSSWALKS.
 3. CONES WILL BE 28" MINIMUM HEIGHT AND HAVE REFLECTORIZED SLEEVES FOR NIGHT WORK.
 4. POLICE WILL DIRECT TRAFFIC IF NECESSARY.

CITY'S FOCUS AREA TO MINIMIZE BLACK FRIDAY IMPACTS

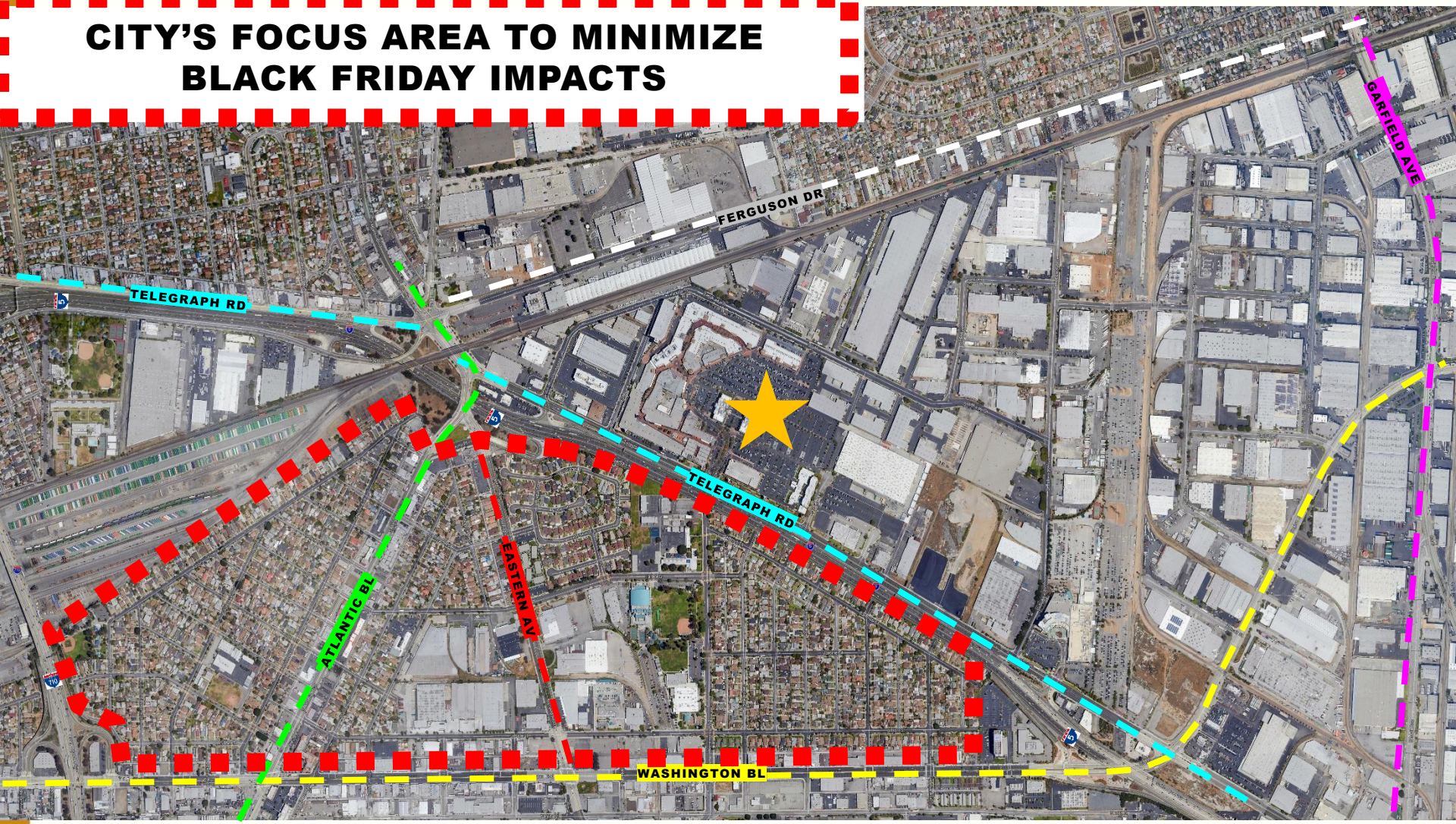


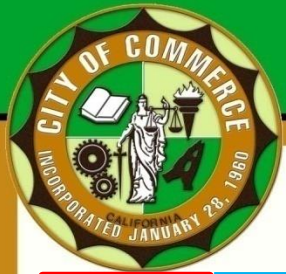

- 1** Closing north bound Eastern north of Washington
- EASTERN AVE IS CLOSED NORTH OF WASHINGTON BL LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY NO ACCESS TO CITADEL OUTLETS**
- 2** Installing resident access only signs at each intersection corner along Atlantic and Eastern between Washington and I-5; and at each intersection corner along Washington between 710 and I-5
- ATTENTION CITADEL SHOPPERS ACCESS FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS ONLY NO ACCESS TO CITADEL**
- 3** Install in each street block on all residential streets between the area covered by 710 (W), Harbor (S), Commerce (E), I-5 (N)
- ATTENTION CITADEL SHOPPERS DO NOT PARK ON CITY STREETS PARKING IS PROVIDED AT CITADEL**
- 4** Installing directional signs along major streets to constantly remind shoppers to proceed to Citadel
- TO CITADEL OUTLETS PARKING** (with arrows pointing up, right, and left)
- 5** Installing CMS (Changeable Message Sign) Electronic Boards at various locations to further notify drivers to proceed to Citadel and not to park on City Streets.
- TO CITADEL SHOPPING CENTER DO NOT PARK ON CITY STREETS**
- 6** Community Safety Officers will be patrolling the impact areas (area with redline) to deter Citadel Parking from using and parking on City streets.
- 7** Traffic Control Company staff will be driving in the impact areas (area with redline) to make sure all signs are in place, and assist if needed Public Safety Officers as needed.

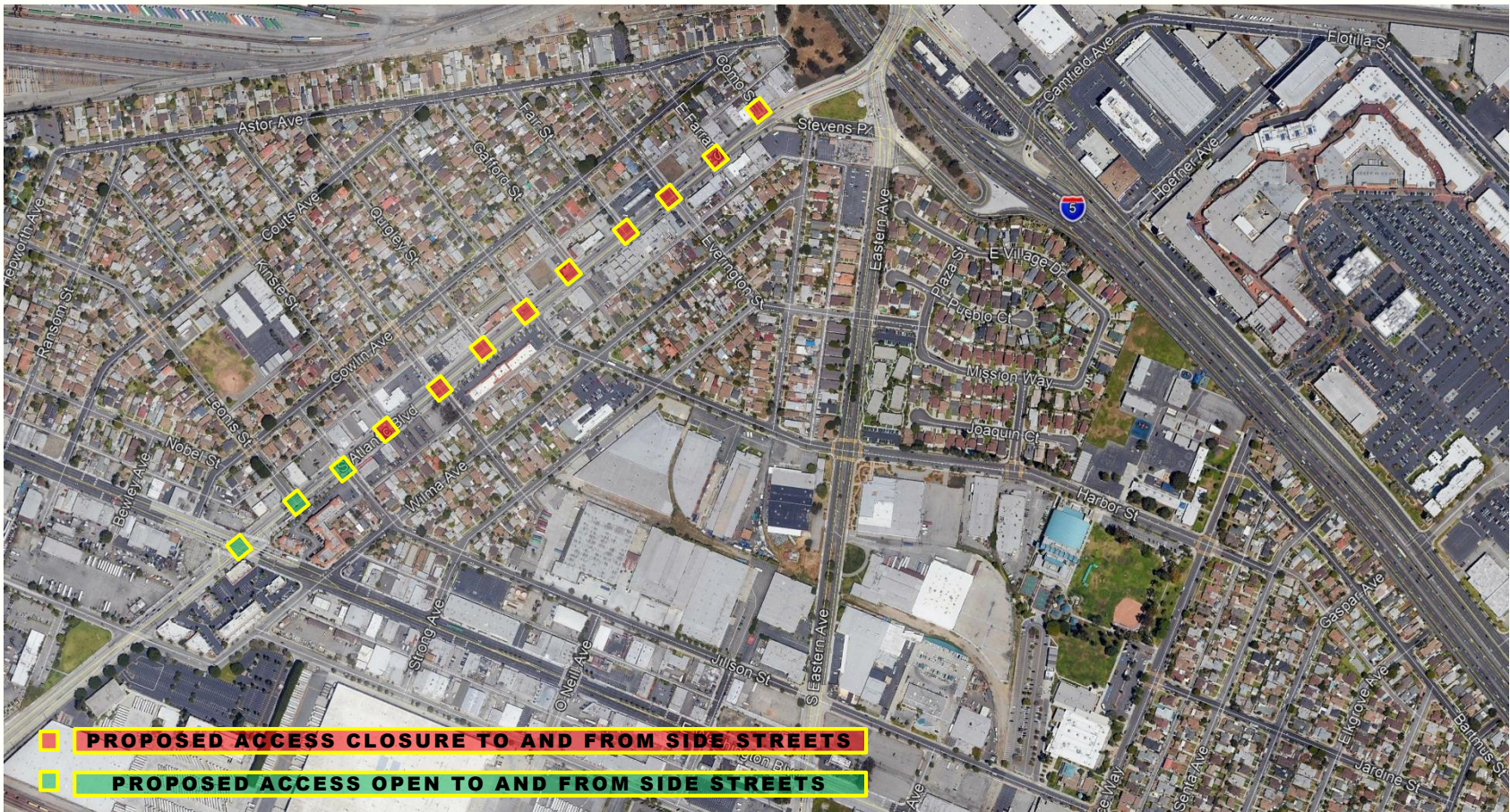
