A Proclamation of the City Council of the City of Commerce Designating the Month of October 2020 as CRIME PREVENTION MONTH

WHEREAS, in 1984 The National Crime Prevention Council designated October as Crime Prevention Month; and

NOW THEREFORE, We, the City Council of the City of Commerce, do hereby join the National Crime Prevention Council in proclaiming the month of October 2020, as "Crime Prevention Month" and encourage all who live and work in the City of Commerce to take a stand against crime and work together to make the City a safer and stronger community.
