**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE,
CALIFORNIA, APPROVING MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE LOS
ANGELES COUNTY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (LACMTA)
FOR PROPOSITION A 40% DISCRETIONARY GRANT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, on November 4, 1980, the voters of the County of Los Angeles approved by majority Proposition A, an ordinance establishing a one-half (1/2) percent sales tax for public transit purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce (City) is an eligible municipal operator to receive Proposition A 40% Discretionary Funds from LACMTA for public transit purposes. The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA) is the administrator of the funds; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA) has issued Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) MOU.PA21COM1000, for Proposition A 40% Discretionary Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding will generate funding in FY 2020-21 of \$291,336; and

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding is in effect from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2030.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Commerce hereby finds and declares that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and incorporates them herein as findings and as a substantive part of this Resolution.

Section 2: Approves Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) MOU.PA21COM1000 for Proposition A 40% Discretionary Grant Funds, with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA).
